In Pursuit at Purdown

Thursday night proved profitable at Purdown for Weston Athletic Club's members with two top five finishes and six age category placings.

The race follows a 10km route around parkland and woodland in north Bristol with a few hills to contend with along the way. Darren Stacey was first back for the club, finishing fifth overall in 41.32. Matt Wheeler placed eighth, and second in his category with his time of 42.22. Stephen Powell followed a minute later in 43.32.

Michelle Fryer was fourth female overall in 48.45, followed by Katie Gormley in 51.33 and Clare Harvey in 53.12.

Adrian Noble and Carol O'Leary won their categories, Helen Diamond came second in hers and Sheryl Selway and Jim Wotton finished third in theirs.

Entries are now open for the 2019/20 Weston prom run series. The five mile races are held every month on Weston's seafront from September to May. Early bird discounted entries are available until the end of August, working out at less than £3 a race. Enter online at www.westonac.co.uk/promrun.
